

## Canto 11, Chapter 6 Overview

- 1-6** Śukadeva Gosvāmī narrates  
Brahmā, Śiva, and a host of *devas*, *upadevas*, &c., travel to Dvārakā, receive Kṛṣṇa's audience, and garland him with flowers.
- 7-19** The Devas pray to Kṛṣṇa in Dvārakā  
The Lord's purity, power, and mercy are extolled.
- 20** Śukadeva Gosvāmī narrates  
The gods conclude, and Brahmā individually petitions the Lord.
- 21-27** Brahmā prays to Kṛṣṇa in Dvārakā  
You have accomplished your mission and are preparing to depart. Please protect us.
- 28-31** Kṛṣṇa replies to Brahmā  
It is necessary for me to take away the Yadus as well. I will visit your abode on the way out.
- 32** Śukadeva Gosvāmī narrates  
Brahmā pays obeisance and departs with the gods. Kṛṣṇa observes disturbances in Dvārakā.
- 34-38** Kṛṣṇa addresses elders of Yadu dynasty in Dvārakā  
Our dynasty has been cursed by the *brāhmaṇas*. We must bathe at Prabhāsa to counteract it.
- 39-41** Śukadeva Gosvāmī narrates  
The Yadavas prepare to depart for Prabhāsa. Uddhava approaches Kṛṣṇa in private.
- 42-49** Uddhava prays to Kṛṣṇa in Dvārakā  
I can tell you are ready to leave this world. Your absence is unbearable. Please take me with you.
- 50** Śukadeva Gosvāmī narrates  
Kṛṣṇa begins to reply, privately and at length, to Uddhava.
